ATTN HORSEMEN: If you are not able to saddle your horse for the races, please arrange for a substitute and inform the stewards thereof; if a valet has to saddle your horse, otherwise your horse could be scratched and/or you could be fined \$100. BY ORDER OF THE STEWARDS.
