Both riders were examined at the track's First Aid station and took off their remaining mounts...Racing's newest millionaire, Grade III winner Comma to the Top, will remain sprinting for the time being, according to winning trainer Peter Miller...Trainer Doug O'Neill indicated that Eddie Logan Stakes winner, Avare, owned in-part by legendary college hoops coach Rick Pitino, would be considered for derby-prep races in the New Year...O'Neill's talented 3-year-old Goldenscents, is definite for the Grade III Sham Stakes at Santa Anita on Jan. 5...Jockey Edwin Maldonado won three races on Saturday, two of them for Miller...Temperature hovered in the mid to high 40s throughout the day Saturday, and snowfall in the 3,000 foot range was visible in the nearby San Gabriel Mountains...Live racing will be offered at Santa Anita through New Year's Day on Tuesday, first post time each day is at 12:30 p.m...Happy 66th birthday to legendary riding great Laffit Pincay Jr. who was a guest on the HRTV set for Saturday's last race...Santa Anita will offer Two Dollar beers, sodas and hot dogs on New Year's Eve, Monday.
