DATING BACK TO HILL GAIL IN 1952, NINE SANTA ANITA DERBY WINNERS HAVE GONE ON TO WIN THE KENTUCKY DERBY. Entries for the Santa Anita Derby will be drawn Wednesday and the 1-2-3-4 finishers in the March 9th San Felipe Stakes are expected to run in the Derby...Doug O'Neill's Goldencents breezed six furlongs at Santa Anita this morning in a bullet 1:14 flat...Cal-breds take center stage on Saturday in a pair of \$200,000 sprints for 3-year-olds going 6 ½ furlongs—The Evening Jewel for fillies and Echo Eddie for all-comers. Purchased privately out of a rousing maiden score, Sweet Marini is the 8-5 favorite in the Evening Jewel, to be run as the sixth race...Omega Star, who exits the San Felipe Stakes, has been installed as the 7-2 morning line favorite in the Echo Eddie, carded as race eight...Jessie Sanchez reports that his mother, injured jockey JOY SCOTT, is recuperating from reconstructive leg surgery at Huntington Memorial Hospital.
