A guaranteed \$500,000 Pick 4 will also be offered. First post time on Derby Day will be 12 noon with gates open at 10 a.m. . . Santa Anita Derby Day 5K Run & Walk is Saturday, April 9. It is expected to have over 5,000 participants, led by jockeys Chantal Sutherland and David Flores. . . Santa Anita Park will offer 80 gourmet food trucks for Food Truck Festival II, on Saturday, April 2. Santa Anita's entire Infield area will be utilized and admission to the Festival is FREE of charge with paid \$5 General Admission, which includes live music and entertainment.
